

Position – Senior Instructor

Position Objectives:

- Provide professional administrative support for club programming

Duties:

- Promote club programs to schools, sport teams, and community groups by public speaking presentations; preparation and delivery of club promotion materials.
- Follow up, book and staff school and community group enquiries.
- Maintain daily record of participants, activities and accomplishments.
- Actively promote the canoe club to participants of club programs with the intent of recruiting potential members.
- Work cooperatively with all staff and instruct canoe and kayak paddling programs.
- As a lead instructor team member, you will be responsible for overseeing the daily operation, safety, security and cleanliness of the canoe club and equipment.
- Mentor volunteer, school and summer instructors.
- Create and deliver a fun and safe program for people of all abilities.
- Respect the club's policies regarding safety, fair play and equity.
- Offer the club constructive feedback on various areas of administration as well as volunteer/junior instructor performance as related to program delivery.
- Accept mentoring and supervision by the club head coach and the program coordinator.
- Other duties as required by the Board or the Head Coach.
